



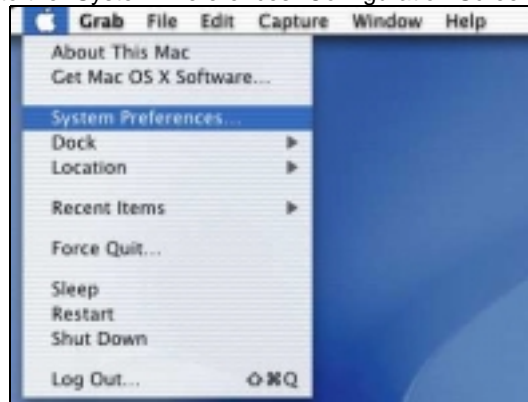
# Macintosh OS X Dial-Up Instructions

This document details how to configure your Macintosh computer running on OS X to dial OpenAccess. If you are using an earlier Macintosh operating system, please refer to the “Macintosh Dial-Up Settings” help sheet.

## 1. Open the “System Preferences” Panel (see Figure 1).

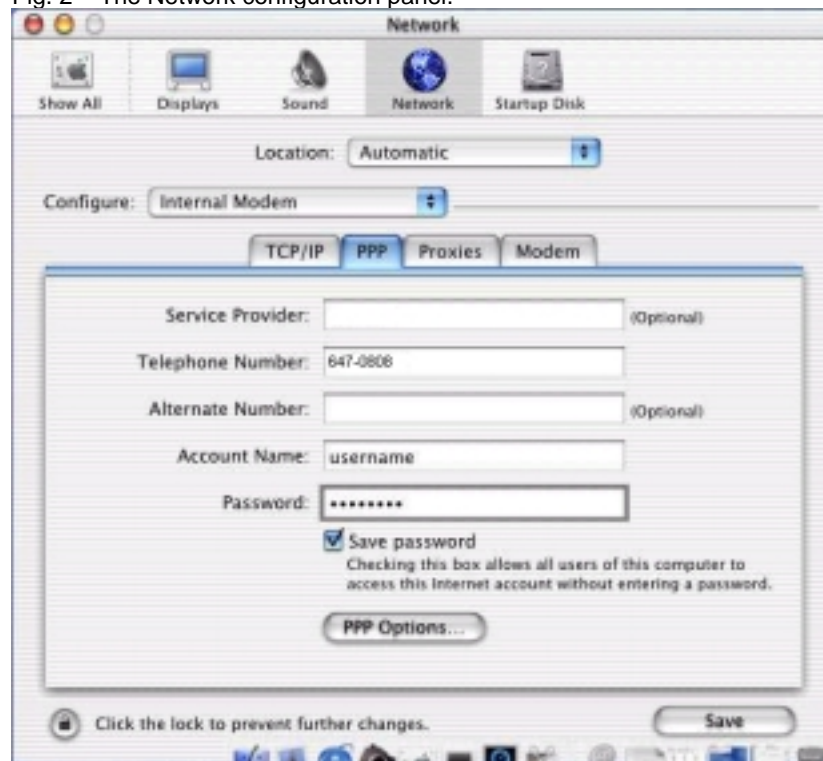
- ◆ Click on the apple to open the “Apple Menu” in the top left-hand corner of the desktop.
- ◆ Select “System Preferences.”

## 2. Click on the “Network” icon at the top of the window (see Figure 2).

**3. Click on the “PPP” tab and enter your information in the text boxes (see Figure 2).**

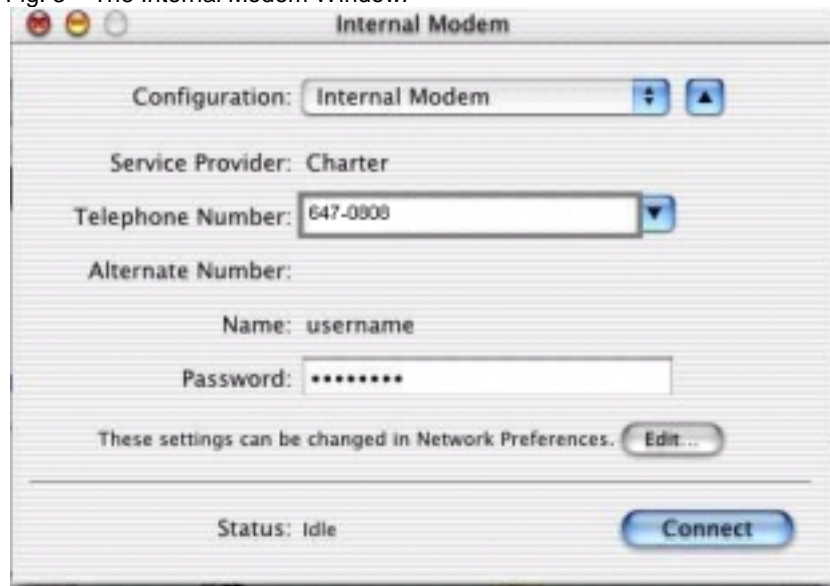
- ◆ In the “Telephone Number:” text box type “647-0808.”
- ◆ Enter the User Name given to you by OpenAccess in the “Account Name” text box.
- ◆ Enter the password given to you by OpenAccess in the “Password” text box.
- ◆ Click on SAVE when you’ve entered all of the information.
- ◆ Close the Network Window.

**4. Click on the “Go” menu at the top of the desktop and select “Applications.”**

**5. Double-click on the “Internet Connections” icon.**

- ◆ This will bring up the “Internal Modem” window (see Figure 3).
